 - a. If this SPECIAL Ensemble includes more than 5 members, it may be conducted by an adult.
- 2. Permission Required, No Transfer Allowed
 - a. For permission, enter EventClassP, i.e. 1087BP, and follow Rule IX.A.1-4.
- 3. For 2 or more mostly vocal performers.
- 4. Instrumentation/voicing must be specified in the score with a maximum of 2 performers per part.
- 5. If the length of a selection exceeds 8 minutes (3/4 of the allotted time), the music may be cut to stay within the 10 minute time limit. If the selection lasts less than 5 minutes, another selection must be added.
- 6. This event encourages music performance that represent indigenous cultures and ethnic groups. Non-traditional, non-Western, or ancient instruments may be used as long as they authentically represent the culture or tradition of the piece being performed.
- 7. A student may enter this event more than once if he/she performs on different instruments.
- 8. One ensemble member is expected to introduce the ensemble at WSMA District and State Festivals, including school name, title of piece, mvts. being performed if appropriate, composer, and provide a verbal explanation of the historical context and performance practices for the ensemble.
