Hockinson High School Band Camp

August 11th-15th, 2025

Dear Parents and Students,

I hope you are as excited as I am to start another year of band at Hockinson High School! If this will be your first year in band at HHS let me be the first to welcome you!

In order to get a jump-start on our year (Husky Band Day and our first home football game are the 2nd and 3rd week of school!) we will be holding our annual band camp **Monday, August 11th thru Friday, August 15th from 9 AM to 4 PM**. There will be one additional day of camp only for percussionists on **Saturday, August 9th from 9 to 4**. Fall sports start August 25th so all band athletes should be able to attend all of camp.

Please dress accordingly for the weather, but make sure to wear shoes and not sandals as we will be marching outside (sometimes on hot pavement). You will be excused each day from 12 to 1 PM for lunch, but it is easiest to just bring a lunch with you. In addition to a lunch, please remember to bring the following:

- Instrument (if you use a school instrument, please email me prior to camp so that I can reserve one for you)
- Pencil
- 3 ring binder with at least 10 clear sheet protectors
- Instrument lyre and flip folder with at least 25 flip folder pages (this includes percussion)
- Water bottle
- Sunscreen

The HHS Music Boosters will be hosting an ice cream social at the conclusion of Thursday's camp. Afterward, there will be a mandatory parent meeting to go over expectations and the year's activities..

In addition, we need to get uniforms fitted and ordered right away. Returning band members will try on their old uniform to make sure everything still fits. There will be an opportunity to purchase new shoes if needed. New band members will need to be fitted for entire uniforms and order marching band shoes. **WE WILL ALSO TAKE OUR BAND PHOTOS DURING BAND CAMP.**

If for some reason you cannot make it to part or all of the camp, please email me **NO LATER THAN July 1** to let me know. I understand families go on vacations during the summer but please try and make your summer plans fit around this camp. The camp should not be blown off; this week will be the only time we rehearse as a full group before our run-through the night of the first football game.

In addition to developing marching fundamentals, learning new music, and putting choreography to our pep band tunes, band camp will also serve as the first opportunity for new students to be introduced to returning students and for sections to begin building relationships with each other. The band council and those who have made band camp their senior project are hard at work planning fun activities and competitions between the sections. Those of you who are returning band members know the importance of the "band family" concept, and those of you who are new will soon experience it!

I have also included a calendar of events for the 2025-2026 school year on the back of this letter. Please be sure to include these dates on your family calendar to avoid vacations, medical appointments, and other immovable conflicts.
